this collection identifies the main theoretical and methodological issues currently preoccupying researchers in social dialectology drawing not only on variation in english in the uk usa new zealand europe and elsewhere but also in arabic greek norwegian and spanish dialects the volume brings together previously unpublished work by the world s most prolific and well respected social dialectologists as well as by some younger dynamic researchers together the authors provide new perspectives on both the traditional areas of sociolinguistic variation and change and the newer fields of dialect formation dialect diffusion and dialect levelling

a conventional wisdom among creolists is that creole is a sociohistorical term only that creole languages share a particular history entailing adults rapidly acquiring a language usually under conditions of subordination but that structurally they are indistinguishable from other languages the articles by john h mcwhorter collected in this volume demonstrate that this is in fact untrue creole languages while complex and nuanced as all human languages are are delineable from older languages as the result of their having come into existence only a few centuries ago then adults learn a language under untutored conditions they abbreviate its

structure focusing upon features vital to communication and shaving away most of the features useless to communication that bedevil those acquiring the language non natively when they utilize their rendition of the language consistently enough to create a brand new one this new creation naturally evinces evidence of its youth specifically a much lower degree of the random accretions typical in older languages which only develop over vast periods of time the articles constitute a case for this thesis based on both broad cross creole ranges of data and focused expositions referring to single creole languages the book presents a general case for a theory of language contact and creolization in which not only transfer from source languages but also structural reduction plays a central role based on facts whose marginality of address in creole studies has arisen from issues sociopolitical as well as scientific for several decades the very definition of the term creole has been elusive even among creole specialists this book attempts to forge a path beyond the inter and intra disciplinary misunderstandings and stalemates that have resulted from this and to demonstrate the place that creoles might occupy in other linguistic subfields including typology language contact and syntactic theory

this book develops a minimalist approach to cross linguistic morphosyntactic variation ian roberts argues that the essential insight of the principles and parameters approach to variation can be maintained albeit in a somewhat different guise in the context of the minimalist programme for linguistic theory the central idea is to organize the parameters of universal grammar ug into hierarchies that define the ways in which properties of individually variant categories and features may act in concert a further leading idea which is consistent with the overall goal of the minimalist programme to reduce the content of ug is that the parameter hierarchies are not directly determined by ug and are instead emergent properties stemming from the interaction of the three factors in language design cross linguistic variation in word order null subjects incorporation verb movement case alignment wh movement and negation are all analysed in the light of this approach this book represents a significant new contribution to the formal study of cross linguistic morphosyntactic variation on both the empirical and theoretical levels and will appeal to researchers and students in all areas of theoretical linguistics and comparative syntax
