


The Law and the Dead

the fate of the dead is a compelling and emotive subject which also raises increasingly complex legal questions this book focuses on the substantive laws around disposal of the recently deceased and associated issues around their post mortem fate it looks primarily at the laws in england and wales but also offers a comparative approach drawing heavily on material from other common law jurisdictions including australia new zealand canada and the united states the book provides an in depth contextual and comparative analysis of the substantive laws and policy issues around corpse disposal exhumation and the posthumous treatment of the dead including commemoration topics covered include the legal frameworks around burial cremation and other disposal methods the hierarchy of persons who have a legal duty to dispose of the dead and who are entitled to possession of the deceased s remains offences against the dead family burial disputes and the legal status of burial instructions the posthumous use of donated bodily material and the rules around disinterment and creating an appropriate memorial a key theme of the book will be to look at the manner in which conflicts involving the dead are becoming increasingly common in secular multi cultural societies where the traditional nuclear family model is no longer the norm and how such legal contests are resolved by courts as the first comprehensive survey of the laws in this area for decades this book will be of use to academics lawyers and judges adjudicating on issues around the fate of the dead as well as the death industry and funeral service providers

a ride on a steam train is a popular family outing more than 100 heritage railways cater for that demand capturing the spirit of nostalgia while preserving the engines and equipment of past days of rail travel their interests even extend to the modern era of 1960 s 70 s diesels those heritage railways themselves have a long pedigree back to 1951 when a group of enthusiasts saved the talyllyn railway in mid wales from closure they ran this railway as volunteers out of their love of the little trains and a desire to keep it going their example was followed by many more preservation societies who preserved and restored branch lines country lines and industrial lines for our enjoyment now six decades have passed and we are now beginning to realize what an impressive history the heritage railway movement has this book traces that history from the humble beginnings the hopes and ambitions of the pioneers on the different railway projects there were times of failure and frustration as some fell by the wayside but others have made it through times of adversity to become the major heritage businesses of today

gary skyner s autobiography you can t you won t a life of unarmed combat provides an honest detailed account of his life as a thalidomide child gary was born severely disabled in 1959 after his mother was prescribed the thalidomide drug during pregnancy originally devised in 1957 by a german pharmaceutical company as a free sedative designed to combat morning sickness thalidomide was first licensed in the uk in 1958 however it became apparent that there was a surge in rare birth defects after pregnant women had been prescribed the drug as one of the earliest in the uk to be born damaged by the deadly drug gary s life was destined to be difficult and challenging as it impaired his physical development expected not to live let alone to achieve much gary is living proof that there is nothing you cannot achieve if you believe you can born with foreshortened arms in the toxteth area of 1950 s liverpool gary explores how his parents marital breakdown and his difficult relationship with his father were all caused in gary s eyes by the strains of raising a disabled child in addition to his troubles at home gary s tears turned to anger as he became aware of the government s reluctance to make

provision for thalidomide victims leading him to become active in campaigns in order to shame them into proper negotiation you can t you won t also explores how gary s dreams came crashing down on him due to his limitations as a thalidomide child as a lifelong liverpool fc supporter he always wanted to be a star player but he soon realised he had to accept his limitations working first as a telephone operator gary later became a welder a housing officer and a trained paralegal despite his difficult life you can t you won t also explores the happier times including having two daughters and his comic and motivational speaker career there has never been a dull moment and this autobiography explores his belief that life should be spiced with jokes and laughter written with conviction and humour you can t you won t is a story of courage and triumph that will appeal to those who enjoy memoirs but also to those interested in the background of thalidomide births

the public intellectual as a person and ideal has a long and storied history writing in venues like the new republic and commentary such intellectuals were always expected to opine on a broad array of topics from foreign policy to literature to economics yet in recent years a new kind of thinker has supplanted that archetype the thought leader equipped with one big idea thought leaders focus their energies on ted talks rather than highbrow periodicals how did this shift happen in the ideas industry daniel w drezner points to the roles of political polarization heightened inequality and eroding trust in authority as ushering in the change in contrast to public intellectuals thought leaders gain fame as single idea merchants their ideas are often laudable and highly ambitious ending global poverty by 2025 for example but instead of a class composed of university professors and freelance intellectuals debating in highbrow magazines thought leaders often work through institutions that are closed to the public they are more immune to criticism and in this century the criticism of

public intellectuals also counts for less three equally important factors that have reshaped the world of ideas have been waning trust in expertise increasing political polarization and plutocracy the erosion of trust has lowered the barriers to entry in the marketplace of ideas thought leaders don t need doctorates or fellowships to advance their arguments polarization is hardly a new phenomenon in the world of ideas but in contrast to their predecessors today s intellectuals are more likely to enjoy the support of ideologically friendly private funders and be housed in ideologically driven think tanks increasing inequality as a key driver of this shift more than ever before contemporary plutocrats fund intellectuals and idea factories that generate arguments that align with their own but while there are certainly some downsides to the contemporary ideas industry drezner argues that it is very good at broadcasting ideas widely and reaching large audiences of people hungry for new thinking both fair minded and trenchant the ideas industry will reshape our understanding of contemporary public intellectual life in america and the west

ranging expertly across business politics and the arts tim harford makes a compelling case for the creative benefits of disorganization improvisation and confusion his liberating message you II be more successful if you stop struggling so hard to plan or control your success messy is a deeply researched endlessly eye opening adventure in the life changing magic of not tidying up oliver burkeman the urge to tidiness seems to be rooted deep in the human psyche many of us feel threatened by anything that is vague unplanned scattered around or hard to describe we find comfort in having a script to rely on a system to follow in being able to categorise and file away we all benefit from tidy organisation up to a point a large library needs a reference system global trade needs the shipping container scientific collaboration needs measurement units but the forces of tidiness have marched too far corporate middle managers and government bureaucrats have long tended to insist that everything must have a label a number and a logical place in a logical system now that they are armed with computers and serial numbers there is little to hold this tidy mindedness in check it s even spilling into our personal lives as we corral our children into sanitised play areas or entrust our quest for love to the soulless algorithms of dating websites order is imposed when chaos would be more productive or if not chaos then messiness the trouble with tidiness is that in excess it becomes rigid fragile and sterile in messy tim harford reveals how qualities we value more than ever responsiveness resilience and creativity simply cannot be disentangled from the messy soil that produces them this then is a book about the benefits of being messy messy in our private lives messy in the office with piles of paper on the desk and unread spreadsheets messy in the recording studio the laboratory or in preparing for an important presentation and messy in our approach to business politics and economics leaving things vague diverse and uncomfortably made up on the spot it s time to rediscover the benefits of a little mess.
