The Continental Shelf 2013-11-22 a the outer limits of the continental shelf the 1982 united nations convention on the law of the sea herein ter the convention marks the beginning of a new era in the law of 1 the sea the negotiations for this treaty at the third united nations conference for the law of the sea hereinafter unclos iii lasted for nine years from 1973 to 1982 the convention regulates the principal aspects of international oceans affairs it establishes and fixes the limits of maritime zones provides for the rights and duties of states in these zones establishes the law app cable in the international seabed area on the basis of the principle of common heritage of mankind imposes obligations on states to protect the marine environment and provides for the means of dispute sett ment one of the most contentious and divisive issues at unclos iii were the outer limits of the continental shelf previously in the 1958 con 2 vention on the continental shelf hereinafter the 1958 convention no limits were established for the continental shelf states were allowed to claim areas of continental shelves based on their capacity to exploit the mineral resources of the shelf the legal framework in the 1958 convention would obviously conflict with the principle of the common heritage of mankind delegates realized that limits have to be est lished but up to where and on the basis of which principles was a c tentious question

Legal and Scientific Aspects of Continental Shelf Limits 1970 one of the reasons for the speed with which international law has been changing in recent years has been the acceleration in the development of technology new technological capabilities create opportunities for new kinds of economic activities which in turn require new legal norms to regulate them many such norms are formulated by express agreement and embodied in multilateral treaties much of contemporary air and space law is being developed by this method for various reasons however the treaty making process is not always adequate for the development of new law at least in its initial stages express agreement of a substantial majority of states on norms formulated with some precision requires much time and effort eighteen years have passed for example since the United Nations International Law Commission began its work on the Law of the Sea which led to the formulation of four conventions at the Geneva Conference of 1958 on this subject ten years after this conference none of the four conventions has been ratified or acceded to by a majority of the states of the world it is not surprising therefore that in some fields new law first emerges as a set of customary norms of varying degrees of clarity and general acceptance but the nature of the process of development and change of customary norms has remained inadequately understood and explained in the theory of international law some eminent jurists have called it a mystery
