dentition introduction to human osteology Apr 14 2023 two parts make up the structure of teeth a portion within the mouth called the crown and a portion within the jaw called the root the outer surface of the crown seen in the mouth is a hard white substance called enamel directly beneath the enamel is a softer material called dentine tooth definition anatomy facts britannica Mar 13 2023 the dentine forms the main bulk or core of each tooth and extends almost the entire length of the tooth being covered by enamel on the crown portion and by cementum on the roots dentine is nourished by the pulp which is the innermost portion of the tooth
