social interaction is a dynamic changing sequence of social actions between individuals or groups who modify their actions and reactions according to those of their interaction partners in other words they are events in which people attach meaning to a situation interpret what others are meaning and respond accordingly social interactions can be differentiated into accidental also known as social contact not planned and likely not repeated for example asking a stranger for directions or shopkeeper for product availability repeated not planned bound to happen from time to time for example accidentally meeting a neighbour when walking on your street regular not planned but very common likely to raise questions when missed meeting a doorman or a security guard every workday in your workplace dining every day in the same restaurant etc regulated planned and regulated by customs or law will definitely raise questions when missed interaction in a workplace coming to work staff meetings playing a game etc family etc in sociological hierarchy social interaction is more advanced than behaviour action social behaviour social action and social contact and is in turn followed by more advanced concept of social relation in other words social interactions which consist of social actions form the basis for social relations this handbook presents the latest international research in the field

in developing the most comprehensive theory of social interaction among humans to date the author has also constructed a general theory of micro dynamics for sociology and social psychology he does so by reviewing existing theories of the past and present synthesizing these concepts into abstract models and principles of social interaction in contrast to talcott parsons and many others the book argues that social interaction rather than action and behaviour is sociology's most basic unit of analysis this unit is conceptualized as involving three processes 1 motivational or the process of mobilizing and energizing interactive behaviour 2 interactional or the process of mutual signaling and interpreting with symbols and 3 structuring or the process of repeating and organizing social interactions in time and place for each of these three constituent processes the relevant theories are analyzed and then synthesized into composite models and general laws

social interaction systems is the culmination of a half century of work in the field of social psychology by robert freed bales a pioneer at the department of social relations at harvard university led by talcott parsons gordon w allport henry a murray and clyde m kluckhohn the harvard project was intended to establish an integrative framework for social psychology one based on the interaction process augmented by value content analysis bales sees this approach as a personal involvement that goes far beyond the classical experimental approach to the study of groups bales developed symlog which stands for systematic multiple level observation of groups the symlog consulting group approach was worldwide as well as interactive it created a data bank that made possible a search for general laws of human interaction far beyond anything thus far known in his daring search for universal features bales redefines the fundamental boundaries of the field and in so doing establishes criteria for the behavior and values of leaders and followers bales offers a new field theory an appreciation of the multiple contexts in which people live bales does not aim to eradicate differences but to understand them in this sense the values inherent in any interaction situation permit the psychologist to appreciate the sources of polarization as they actually exist between conservative and liberal individualistic and authoritarian libertarian and communitarian bales repeatedly emphasizes that the mental processes of individuals and their social interactions take place in systematic contexts which can be measured hence they permit explanation and prediction of behavior in a more exact way than in past traditions bales has offered a pioneering work that has the potential to move us into a new theoretical epoch no less than a new century his work holds out the promise of synthesis and support for psychologists sociologists and all who work with groups and organizations of all kinds

within the study of language and social interaction the concept of accountability including related concepts such as account or motive accounting and being accountable has been of longstanding interest in terms of how interactants in both ordinary and organizational contexts manage their image or reputation as well as how they achieve mutual understanding however these concepts are polysemous with different senses being rather dramatic such as accountability as moral responsibility and accountability as intelligibility even today this fact is not always remembered or fully recognized or appreciated by scholars which has arguably slowed the development of these concepts this volume brings together a collection of novel conversation analytic studies addressing accountability with the goal of re-exposing its multiple senses reiterating their interrelationships and in doing so breaking new conceptual ground and exposing new pathways for future research the collection considers central theoretical issues including turn taking sequence and preference organization repair membership categorization action formation and ascription social solidarity and affiliation and the relevance of context chapters range contextually canvassing interactions between friends and family members and during talk shows broadcast news interviews airline reservations and medical visits chapters also range culturally including english japanese and korean data
