explained the examples typically following the explanation of a topic are too few in number and too simple to enable the student to obtain a thorough grasp of the involved principles the explanations do not provide sufficient basis to solve problems that may be assigned for homework or given on examinations poorly solved examples such as these can be presented in abbreviated form which leaves out much explanatory material between steps and as a result requires the reader to figure out the missing information this leaves the reader with an impression that the problems and even the subject are hard to learn completely the opposite of what an example is supposed to do poor examples are often worded in a confusing or obscure way they might not state the nature of the problem or they present a solution which appears to have no direct relation to the problem these problems usually offer an overly general discussion never revealing how or what is to be solved many examples do not include accompanying diagrams or graphs denying the reader the exposure necessary for drawing good diagrams and graphs such practice only strengthens understanding by simplifying and organizing accounting processes students can learn the subject only by doing the exercises themselves and reviewing them in class obtaining experience in applying the principles with their different ramifications in doing the exercises by themselves students find that they are required to devote considerable more time to accounting than to other subjects because they are uncertain with regard to the selection and application of the theorems and principles involved it is also often necessary for students to discover those tricks not revealed in their texts or review books that make it possible to solve problems easily students must usually resort to methods of trial and error to discover these tricks therefore finding out that they may sometimes spend several hours to solve a single problem when reviewing the exercises in classrooms instructors usually request students to take turns in writing solutions on the boards and explaining them to the class students often find it difficult to explain in a manner that holds the interest of the class and enables the remaining students to follow the material written on the boards the remaining students in the class are thus too occupied with copying the material off the boards to follow the professor s explanations this book is intended to aid students in accounting overcome the difficulties described by supplying detailed illustrations of the solution methods that are usually not apparent to students solution methods are illustrated by problems that have been selected from those most often assigned for class work and given on examinations the problems are arranged in order of complexity to enable students to learn and understand a particular topic by reviewing the problems in sequence the problems are illustrated with detailed step by step explanations to save the students large amounts of time that is often needed to fill in the gaps that are usually found between steps of illustrations in textbooks or review outline books the staff of rea considers accounting a subject that is best learned by allowing students to view the methods of analysis and solution techniques this learning approach is similar to that practiced in various scientific laboratories particularly in the medical fields in using this book students may review and study the illustrated problems at their own pace students are not limited to the time such problems receive in the classroom when students want to look up a particular type of problem and solution they can readily locate it in the book by referring to the index that has been extensively prepared it is also possible to locate a particular type of problem by glancing at just the material within the boxed portions each problem is numbered and surrounded by a heavy black border for speedy identification
