officially called the fighting falcon by the usaf a name loathed by pilots and ground crews the f 16 is popularly referred to as the viper first introduced into service with the usaf in 1978 the f 16 is a successful all weather multi role jet fighter of which more than 4 500 have been built and exported to 25 countries worldwide it remains in service more than 30 years later the viper incorporates a number of innovative design features that include a frameless bubble canopy for better visibility pilot s side mounted control stick for ease of control when manoeuvring a seat reclined 30 degrees to reduce the effect of g forces on the pilot and the first use of a relaxed static stability fly by wire flight control system that makes the viper a highly agile aircraft at the business end the f 16 has an internal m61 vulcan cannon and eleven weapon mounting stations

the avro shackleton was a formidable machine with its griffon engines producing the characteristic grumble that gave the aircraft one of its nicknames the growler this book contains stories from the men for whom the aircraft became a way of life combining memories and anecdotes from crew members with archive material including rare and previously unseen photographs growling over the oceans is an intimate and vivid introduction to the world of the shack in the last days of world war two the makers of the lancaster bomber began to consider designing a new aircraft for coastal command it eventually became the shackleton the men who flew and serviced the production version became fiercely proud of their aeroplane and its lack of home comforts the shackleton s ten man crews became a legend their aeroplane was noisy gloomy and demanded constant maintenance but it bred a aircrew who became inured to long thundering and monotonous flight and developed even taking a perverse pride in their misfortunes the shackleton served in anti submarine warfare maritime reconnaissance and colonial policing the cold war ensured that the threat of unrestricted submarine warfare against british shipping kept the shackleton on permanent alert for twenty years it also became a troop transport a bomber and a search and rescue aircraft when the need arose from its first public flight in 1949 to the end of the cold war when the shackleton finally retired from service and entered history this book provides many reminiscences some amusing some serious of those who flew in the shack the aircraft that struck more fear into its own crew than it did the enemy

Their purpose was to explore the lives of RAF and East German fighter and fighter bomber pilots in the air and on the ground at work and play during the Cold War in North Germany. The book is based largely on personal testimony from these pilots, coupled with facts drawn from official archives and comment from other historical sources where possible. Political considerations have been avoided and no outright criticism has been intended; readers are left to draw their own conclusions on the thinking, strategies, equipment, and tactics discussed. Far from being an intellectual polemic on the Cold War, the text and photographs merely record a slice of history as seen through the eyes of a select few who took up arms in the defense of their respective homelands and faced each other daily across the Iron Curtain. In an insightful conclusion, Nigel Walpole reassesses the threat that both sides believed was genuine during those tense decades of the Cold War and examines the possible course and nature of a conflict which neither NATO nor the Warsaw Pact wanted but both actively planned for. The writer has avoided politics where possible and in doing so reassesses the threat and uncertainty and ultimately the fears both air forces faced. It's a truly fascinating flypast.

with the approach of ww2 the de havilland aerodrome at hatfield went through a major expansion concentrating on mosquito production and development the company also pioneered the production and development of jet engines led by major frank halford leading to the vampire jet fighter early commercial aircraft were the dove and heron but the major pioneering programme was the comet the world s first commercial jet airliner which first flew on 27 july 1949 and entered service with boac on 2 may 1952 the dh 108 tailless research aircraft based on the vampire fuselage was used to investigate the effects of the speed of sound exceeding mach 1 on 9 september 1948 the de havilland jet airliner developed through the trident which was the first aircraft capable of automatic landing with passengers in all weathers leading to the bae 146 whisper jet britain s most successful jet airliner in addition to developing turbojet engines the engine company also developed rocket engines the propeller company developed air to air guided missiles and the blue streak stage 1 booster space rocket other types developed by de havilland at hatfield were the sea vixen naval strike fighter and the dh 125 business jet
